PROCEEDINGS OF THE RIVER REJUVENATION COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON 04.6.2019 AT 5.00 P.M. IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF FOREST & ENV. DEPARTMENT,

GOVT. OF ODISHA

The third meeting of the River Rejuvenation Committee (RRC) of State of

Odisha was held on 04.6.2019 under the Chairmanship of Additional Chief

Secretary, Forest & Env. Department, Govt. of Odisha in the Conference Hall of

Forest & Env. Department. The list of participants is enclosed at Annexure-I.

Initiating the discussion, Addl. Chief Secretary welcomed the members.

The Chief Environmental Scientist, SPC Board, Odisha presented the compliance

of the orders of Hon'ble NGT as well as the action taken on the decision of the

1st and 2nd RRC meeting. The comments received from CPCB on the Action Plan

submitted for Priority-I river stretch i.e., Ganqua as well as for other 8 polluted

river stretches were discussed. The Action Plan prepared for remaining 10

polluted river stretches were also discussed.

Addl. Chief Secretary requested all stakeholder Dept. to furnish information

within a week time in order to meet the dateline i.e., 30.6.2019 for submission of

revised Action Plans to CPCB. After detail deliberation the following decision

were taken.

1. The committee approved the following 10 action plans and

recommended to submit these action plans to CPCB within the stipulated

date line i.e., 30.6.2019 after incorporating the information to be received

from OWSSB and H & UD Dept.

(Action: SPCB, Odisha)

2. The list of polluted locations for the year 2018, which has already been shared with the H & UD Department, may also be shared with the PR &

DW Department, for taking necessary actions under Swachh Bharat Mission.

(Action: SPC Board, Odisha)

3. PR & DW Dept. to take all necessary action under Swachh Bharat Mission for abatement of river water pollution in the above 10 stretches.

(Action: Panchayati Raj & Drinking Water Department)

4. As either single marginal or no of exceedence of BOD values over the tolerance limit has been observed during the last two year in these above 10 river stretches, It was recommended to write to Hon'ble NGT with proper justification for deletion of these 10 stretches from the list of Polluted River Stretch.

(Action: SPC Board, Odisha)

 It was decided that the public toilet / community toilet and pipe water supply are to be provided in slums along all 10 major drains leading to Gangua nallah to reduce pollution load.

(Action: OWSSB and H & UD Department)

OWSSB will provide detail progress of STPs under construction, Septage
Management Plan, fund position, time line for completion of each STPs,
septage management in the State of Odisha within a week.

(Action: OWSSB)

7. The committee took a view that observations of CPCB on the action plan submitted for Priority-I Polluted river stretch, such as Flood Plain Zone protection and its management, Rain water harvesting, groundwater recharge aspect, Maintaining E-Flows and water shed management, Good irrigation practices setting up of Biodiversity parks including removal of encroachment and plantation on both sides of river etc for rejuvenation are not practically implementable for such a small storm water drain, like Gangua, which is

approximately 30-40 Km long. Therefore it was decided to inform CPCB with enough justification for un-implementability of some of the observations.

(Action: SPC Board, Odisha)

8. Water Resource Dept. shall continue to discharge water of Daya West Canal to Gangua nallah through Palasuni escape till the monsoon.

(Action: Water Resource Department)

9. The Water Resource Dept. shall ensure no discharge of wastewater of Cuttack city to river Kathajodi through Khan Nagar Sluice Gate.

(Action: Water Resources Dept.)

10. The authority of Rourkela Steel Plan shall be requested to release water from Mandira Dam to Sankh river to increase the flow in river Brahmani.

(Action: SPC Board, Odisha)

11. The action points for the 9 polluted river stretches shall be circulated to concerned Depts. for submission of action taken report so far taken for discussion in the next River Rejuvenation Committee Meeting.

(Action: SPC Board, Odisha)

12. The SPCB shall make a survey of the wastewater drains apart from the 10 major drains leading to Gangua nallah for identification of source of pollution.

(Action: SPC Board, Odisha)

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
